Scholarships

It has been a part of the **Pegasus tradition** for the past 20 years to support our community through the development of scholarship programs.

We are proud to have supported our students with over \$80,000 in tuition credits for dance and art education at Pegasus Dance Studios.

In the past we have given two scholarships in memory of **Robyn Barhydt** and **Michael Davis**.

These scholarships are given to students who bring joy and passion to their dance classes and to the Pegasus community while

understanding and demonstrating the Pegasus philosophy of enthusiasm, determination, kindness and respect for their peers, teachers and themselves.

In addition to these scholarships we accepted donations in memory or celebration of a family member or loved one in honor of our co-founder **Lynda Johnson**. Through her vision we encourage a student each year to continue their study of the arts and to participate in the process of developing their physical, artistic and creative potential, regardless of their financial abilities. This award is not publicized, but

given to an individual we feel needs financial assistance to continue their dance training.

This year we are excited to announce that all three scholarships will go under the new name of **Chance to Dance** Scholarships and will continue to look for donations from local businesses and individuals to support these scholarships and our Darby's Dancer program. We would love to chat with you about how you can get involved! We need your help and that of our community to continue to support our children in the Arts.

Brief History

Thirty five years ago, Pegasus Dance and Art Centre was founded by the mother and daughter team of Lynda Johnson and Jane Davis-Munro. Their aim was to create a community where children would feel seen, heard and be free to discover and develop their inborn natural abilities to communicate and express themselves through the arts. Children are born with a natural curiosity to discover the world around them and Pegasus Studios has continued to offer programs for expanding interests and passions for the arts since the beginning. When exploring our world through movement, music, imagination and art, we have a chance to nurture children to be creative, critical thinkers that will give them the skills needed in any field they choose in the future.

Classes were first held in Lynda's basement and were primarily, what is now, the renowned Childhood Expressions Fine Arts Program. We then found a little storefront at Greenwood and Queen and opened Pegasus Childrens' Dance and Art Centre.

Our next home, where we continue to this day, is Kimbourne Park United Church where we realized we could serve more families and children in this location. We have been blessed to have continued our mission by growing and serving the children in this community over the past 35 years. Kimbourne Park United Church built the adjoining building that holds our studios to serve a Sunday School and recreational programs for a congregation of 600 plus children. Although we do not have that many children in our programs we continue to serve the children of this community in a space that was its original intention.

In 1996 Lynda retired from teaching at Pegasus. She continued her career as a visual artist until her passing in 2013. Lynda's presence will continue to be felt at

Jane continues as Artistic Director of the school, and the programs have grown with the addition of wonderful and talented faculty, leadership team and staff. Jane prides herself on making dance a positive experience for all children and looks for faculty that share her philosophy of providing an atmosphere where children can explore, create, express and develop their inborn creative spirit through the arts. We look forward to the next 35 years!


